

## **Gospel Reflection**

The theme of repentance and forgiveness is developed in the Gospel for the 3rd Sunday of Easter. Here, the risen Jesus appears to His disciples, offering them peace and dispelling their fears. By showing His hands and feet and sharing a meal with them, Jesus demonstrates the reality of His physical resurrection. He then opens their minds to understand the Scriptures, showing how His suffering, death, and resurrection were all part of God's salvific plan. This moment is not just a revelation of the mystery of the Resurrection but also an invitation to the disciples to become witnesses to the forgiveness of sins through Jesus' name.

The readings for this Sunday also challenge us to live as witnesses to the Resurrection, embodying the hope and renewal it signifies. The resurrection of Jesus is not just a historical event; it is a reality that has the power to transform our lives today. By rising from the dead, Jesus has conquered sin and death, opening the way for us to live in newness of life.

As witnesses to the Resurrection, we are called to share the message of forgiveness and hope with the world. Jesus' instruction to His disciples to preach repentance and forgiveness of sins to all nations is also a mandate for us. In a world marked by division and despair, the message of the Resurrection is a beacon of hope. It is a reminder that love is stronger than death, and that God's mercy can transform even the darkest situations. As we reflect on these themes, let us open our hearts to the power of the Resurrection, allowing it to renew us in spirit and in truth. Let us walk in the light of Christ, confident in His love and mercy, and eager to share the Good News of His Resurrection with all whom we meet.

#### **Reflection Questions**

- In what ways have I experienced God's forgiveness in my life, and how has it transformed my relationship with Him and with others?
- Reflect on a time when you felt like the disciples—confused or doubtful about your faith. How did you come to recognize Jesus in your midst, and what changed for you?
- The disciples were called to be witnesses of Jesus' resurrection. In what ways am I called to witness to the resurrection in my own life? Are there specific actions or changes I feel called to make?
