We the Catholic community of Our Lady of Fatima united by faith, are called by God and empowered by the Holy Spirit to evangelize and assist in the faith formation of all.

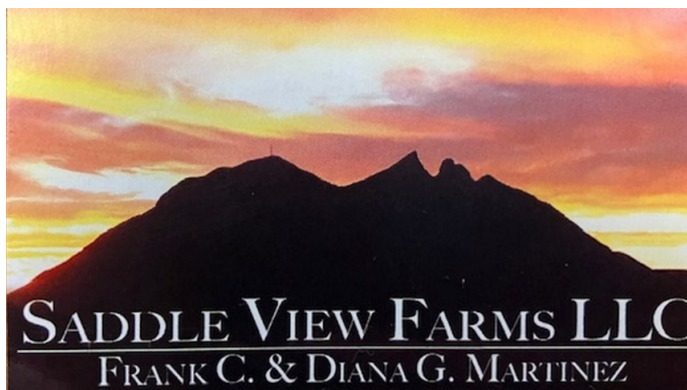
We are committed to encourage, affirm and call forth everyone into participation by providing opportunity for ministry.

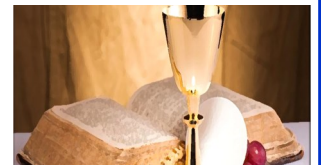

SCRIPTURE READINGS:

First Reading: Amos 7:12-15

Resp. Psalm: Psalm 85

Second Reading: Ephesians 1:3-14

Gospel: Mark 6:7-13

Gospel Reflection

The themes for the 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B remind us that God calls us all to serve Him. We are blessed in Christ and should trust in God as we carry out our mission.

In the first reading, we hear about Amos being called from being a simple shepherd by God to be a prophet and speak God's message to Israel even though he did not seek this role.. In the second reading from Ephesians, we learn about the spiritual blessings we have in Christ. We are chosen to be holy, redeemed by Jesus' sacrifice and sealed with the Holy Spirit.

The Gospel reading shows Jesus sending out the Twelve apostles. Jesus calls the apostles from their daily work and gives them authority over unclean spirits. He tells them to travel light and rely on God. They are to preach repentance and heal the sick. This teaches us about faith and trust in God.

Trust is key in our mission. Jesus told the apostles to take only what was necessary. They had to rely on the hospitality of others. This means trusting God to provide for us as we do His work.

Repentance is also important. The apostles preached repentance to everyone they met. This is a call for us to turn away from sin and follow God more closely. Repentance leads to a closer relationship with God.

The readings this week remind us of our mission. God calls each of us to a mission, and regardless of our background, we too are called to serve God in our lives and trust in His guidance. We should listen for His call and be ready to respond. As we respond to His call, we grow in faith and love

Reflection Questions

- How do you hear God's call in your life?
- What does Jesus' instruction to the apostles teach you about relying on God?
- How can you share God's love with those around you?

Supplies can be dropped off at the Parish Office anytime prior to Fair Week.

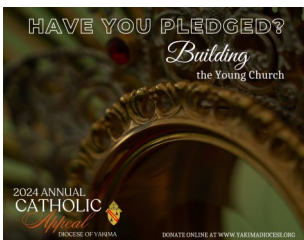

FAMILY CONNECTION

Families who work together to accomplish routine household tasks know that the benefits are more than efficiency. In sharing daily tasks, we accomplish more, but we also build relationships that last—and it's a lot more fun! Jesus sent his disciples in pairs to minister in his name. Perhaps the job was accomplished more effectively this way, but more importantly, Jesus' mission was accomplished more authentically. The Christian message can only authentically be proclaimed in and through the community of faith. In our work with others, we build this community of faith and can invite others to share in it.

As you gather as a family, talk about some household tasks that are more easily accomplished when two or more people work together. Talk about how working together not only makes the job easier, but also makes the task more fun because we are able to spend time together. Read together today's Gospel, Mark 6:7-13. Ask: Why do you think Jesus sent out his disciples in pairs? Observe that Jesus continues to give us a community with which we share our life of discipleship—our family and the community of the Church. Conclude in prayer together that we will continue to rely on the support of the community of the Church in our life of discipleship.

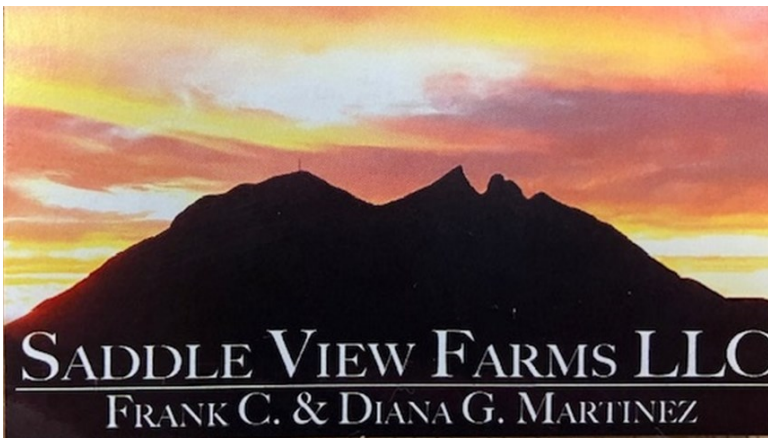
