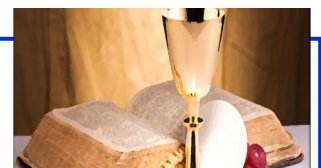

SCRIPTURE READINGS:

First Reading: Proverbs 9:1-6

Resp. Psalm: Psalm 34

Second Reading: Ephesians 5:15-20

Gospel: John 6:51-58

Gospel Reflection

The themes for the 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B guide us to live wisely, nourish our spirits with Christ in the Eucharist, and be thankful. These readings remind us that true life and joy are found in following Jesus and living according to God's will.

In John 6:51-58, Jesus tells us He is the living bread that came down from heaven. He says that anyone who eats this bread will live forever. This bread is His flesh, given for the life of the world.

Jesus contrasts this with the manna the ancestors ate in the desert. They ate the manna and still died. But those who partake in Jesus, the living bread, will have eternal life.

This teaching is central to our faith. Jesus offers Himself as our spiritual nourishment. By receiving Him in the Eucharist, we are united with Him and receive the promise of eternal life.

The readings for this Sunday guide us to live wisely and seek true nourishment in Jesus. They remind us of the importance of wisdom, the call to live according to God's will, and the promise of eternal life through Jesus. Let us strive to apply these teachings in our daily lives.

Prayer: Lord, help us to seek wisdom and live wisely. Guide our steps and fill us with your Holy Spirit. Nourish us with your presence and keep us thankful and joyful. Amen.

Reflection Questions

- What does it mean to me that Jesus is the living bread?
- How can I share the message of Jesus, the living bread, with others?
- What impact does receiving the Eucharist have on my life?

FAMILY CONNECTION

Our faith teaches us that when we gather to celebrate the Eucharist, Jesus himself is present to us. Through the actions of the Mass, the bread and wine truly become the Body and Blood of Christ. This is what we mean by the word transubstantiation. Jesus makes himself present to all who receive the Body and Blood of Christ.

If there are children in your family who have already celebrated their First Communion, invite them to share their memories of this special day. If you have family photos from this occasion, bring them out and share them. Adults in the family may also share memories or photos of their First Communion. Then read together today's Gospel, John 6:51-58. Reflect together on what Jesus means when he calls himself the "living bread." Recall that every time we receive the Eucharist, Jesus keeps the promise he made in today's Gospel. Perhaps family members can share what it means for them to receive Jesus in the Eucharist. Together, thank God for this gift of Holy Communion. Pray together the Lord's Prayer or today's psalm..

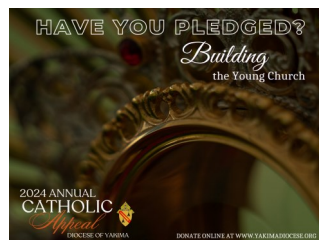

Ticket Prices: \$2.00 each or 3 for \$5.00.

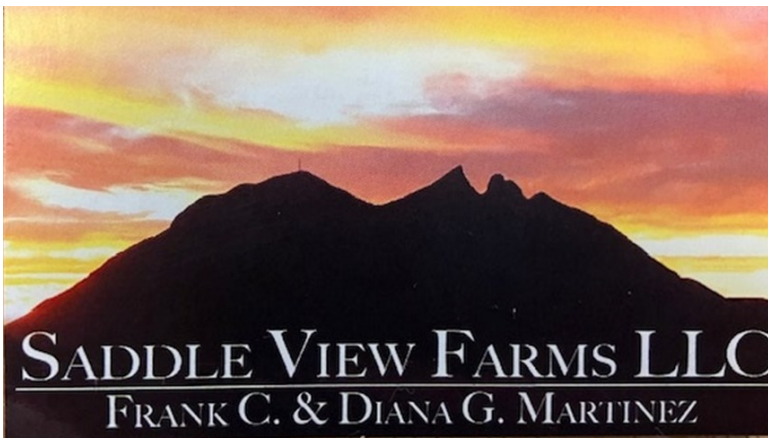
